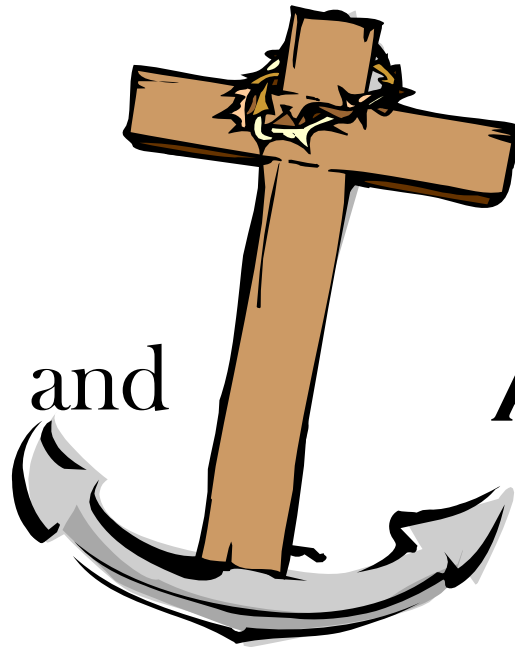

First Baptist Colleyville**

Former atheist, Evangelist and Apologist Frank Harber, Senior Pastor of First Baptist Colleyville, Texas now speaks about the truthfulness of Christianity. Dr. Harber was converted to Christ after

doing an historical investigation to disprove Christianity. In addition to leading his congregation of 3,500, he is the author of several books including *Sherlock's Faith The Investigation of Christianity*, as well as co-creator of the **got life?** apologetics-based evangelism strategy. *The Real Life with Frank Harber*, a weekly radio program hosted by Dr. Harber, is heard on over 600 radio stations daily.

Dr. Harber is a graduate of Southwestern Seminary, where he holds the fastest earned Ph.D., graduating in a record setting two and one half years. He has preached in over 600 churches in the United States and has spoken on Christian issues concerning "Faith and Family" on over 200 television programs, including hosting a five part television special for Family Net entitled "Essential Christianity." Since his conversion from atheism he has preached to more than 2,000,000 persons face to face including citywide and area crusades in the United States and around the world. Dr. Harber was personally invited by Dr. Billy Graham to speak at Amsterdam 2000 on the subject, "The Evangelist and Apologetics."

Dr. Harber and his wife Becky live in Colleyville, Texas with their three children, Graham, Gabrielle, and Hunter.

FIRST HISPANIC BAPTIST CHURCH

Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him. Isaiah 64:4

How can the events and circumstances of our times promote God's purposes? Economic and political crises produce the movements of persons such that mission fields are transplanted to our backdoor. Some examples of ministry to the Spanish-speaking in Fannin County in which we are involved include Spanish Bible study at Choice Moore State Prison, English classes through the Texoma Council of Governments, interpretation, help to single - parent families, food and utility bill help, referrals for employment, marriage counseling, tutoring, house repairs, disaster relief through the Red Cross, and of course Christian evangelism and discipleship. Many of the common problems of life are compounded by the language barrier for Hispanic families. That is why I would encourage mission minded youth to learn Spanish. Such efforts would not be wasted but can immediately be put to use in our community.

So much of what has happened this year has resulted in an even greater conviction regarding God's purposes here for the Spanish-speaking community. This summer a female ministry intern from Ecuador spent two months here ministering to ladies during the day with encouragement and spiritual guidance. On September 11th there were 50 people present at our baptismal service and all but one of them live in this community. Through God's grace and the generosity of several persons and churches, the building and three acres of land that the ministry purchased in March of 1999 has been paid off four years early. That gives the ministry plenty of room for parking and facilities for years to come. The air conditioning unit in the auditorium was replaced this summer for better cooling and energy efficiency. We are looking to purchase a used riding lawn mower as well for the spring. Our property is located on Highway 273 North a few miles south of Lake Bonham across from the Kwik Chek Store.

In closing, we who are part of the Hispanic ministry want to thank many of you for your prayers and support. Let's have a great year for the Lord.

WMU Summit: On April 28-30, 2005, Wanda Poindexter, Jean Standifer, and Sylvia Hall attended this conference at River Bend Encampment at Glen Rose. Texas WMU is celebrating 125 years.

We had the privilege of seeing God continue to faithfully change students’ lives, moving many to become more faithful witnesses and involving more than ever since I have been here in missions, discipleship, and ministry opportunities.

Student Leadership is always the key to everything God is able to accomplish in our BSM. We had a great group of student leaders. They led excellent ministries to new students, involving many in small group Bible studies. Our Kids’ Klub ministry added a new location, working with the Boys and Girls Club of Commerce and at a local day-care. Our students got to minister to dozens of kids, and were able to lead several children to Christ! Outreach ministries were very effective in touching the lives of literally hundreds of students on campus through dorm trash pick-ups, hot chocolate give-aways, and coffee houses. Twenty-six students served on our Leadership and New Student leadership teams. Twelve of our students have felt God’s call to vocational ministry.

Evangelism ministries saw impressive student involvement, with 25 participating in faith-sharing strategies. We had 12 students accept Christ this year on our campus, and over 200 students attended our Rez Week concert and luncheon where they heard the gospel clearly presented, in addition to the hundreds of students who come to our weekly luncheon ministry and hear about Christ.

Missions awareness and involvement was another area we saw God’s hand in again. We took our largest group ever – 34 students! – on our Christmas mission trip to an orphanage in Matamoros, Mexico. Students again helped raise over \$5000 for summer missions this year. We had nine students serve as summer missionaries, from China to Nicaragua and Colorado to San Antonio, and two of our students are serving on BSM staffs.

All together we had over 435 students participate in almost two dozen weekly ministries – almost a 50% increase from last year, with over 750 other students ministered to. We had almost 40 International students involved in our activities. Obviously, none of these blessings would have been realized without the support of our local churches and Associations. Your prayers and your giving have made these works of God possible, and for that we are eternally grateful.

Prison Ministry

"I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me." *Matthew 25:36*

The Fannin County Prison Ministry was called into service February 2001. It started with just 30 members. Many other churches and organizations have had people presenting the Gospel in prisons earlier than this team. Our goal is to bring the people that are already organized in their churches to cooperatively hold the monthly worship services and to assure that the six available positions are filled. This instills a strong united effort to reach the lost and to minister to the saved offenders in these units. The state has set a limit of six volunteers per visit. The total people count in the worship service includes the volunteers. If all six volunteers do not show up, then there are empty seats that cannot be filled with offenders. If the men in these units see less than six volunteers, they tend to question our commitment in our own Judea.

Today God has continued to grow this Ministry. We are now involving all Fannin county Churches and reaching out to the Grayson, Hunt, Lamar and Delta counties with an endeavor to join hands and hearts and preach and teach the gospel to youth prisons, adult prisons and ex-offenders.

The Great Commission Matthew 28:18

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

We have the new applications available at the FBA office. Training is done monthly and requires less than half a day to complete. I will be available to assist anyone or any church to be involved in this ministry.
